The association also conducts programs to certify Concrete Flatwork Technicians / Finishers. These are conducted on a request basis and can be held in any area of the state.

**Seminars and Presentations** – The Product Education Program presents multiple seminars and presentations on a wide variety of concrete topics around the state to architects, engineers, contractors, public officials, homebuilder associations and industry personnel.

**Meetings** – The Annual Convention is a two-day event for all members. Held in a vacation type atmosphere combined with meaningful business meetings and seminars. Members are given an opportunity to develop important relationships with others in the industry. Exhibit tables allow association members to display their products and services with plenty of time to visit with producer members.

The Mid-Year Meeting in the fall is focused on industry owners and managers with an emphasis of presentations on the latest technology or current business recommendations.
